**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Wise called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

**ATTENDANCE**

Council Members Beckwith, Jensen, Ennis, Hogan, L. Reynolds, Mahelona, and Coats were present. Also present were Mayor Wise, City Administrator Bauer, City Attorney Reynolds, City Clerk Hopkins, and Finance Director Smalling.

**OPENING REMARKS**

Mayor Wise reviewed the agenda and said that the Council Project Goals and Policy Statement, established in 2002 by Council, would be reviewed and compared to the 2006 Program of Work.

Bauer noted that Council had requested this workshop and gave some background on the Council Project Goal Policy Statement. He said the 2006 Programs of Work are included in the agenda packet as well. He said a Fire Strategic Plan was still needed.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

Council had general discussion of the Council Project Goals and Policy Statement and the 2006 Programs of Work and what their purpose is and how it relates to the budget. Council reviewed and prioritized the Council Project Goals and Policy Statement's high priority items and created a time line for each. A top ten list was agreed upon including upgrade the sewer treatment plant, Welcome Center, tourism, 410 Corridor plan, capital funding long range plan, regional trail, local portion, new community center, collector and neighborhood street improvement project, and code enforcement program. They deleted some items and moved completed items to a "Completed Project Goals" list. Council requested the remaining medium and low items be emailed to them to prioritize and they would add items to the list, if desired.

Bauer said he will make the revisions to the Council Project Goals and Policy Statement as discussed and email the Council the updated version to prioritize the remaining items and collect any new additions.

**ADJOURNMENT:**

Mayor Wise adjourned the meeting at 9:00 p.m.
