#### **II. NEW BUSINESS**

- A. Resolution No. 1752, Chinook Scenic Byway Sign. Searcy gave an overview and history for the request. The sign has dual purpose. East bound – Chinook Scenic Byway, west bound- Welcome to the City of Enumclaw. Currently, there has been work done and start foundation. The council approved funding for the sign not to exceed \$10,000. An agreement regarding responsibilities for each party was never proposed and this resolution. This would allow them to fund raise to finish the project. Asked for an easement for 10 years to keep the sign where it is so as to prevent the sign from being moved. Discussion regarding approval of Resolution No. 1752, recommended approval.
- B. Streeteries – Wright discussed the background on the streeteries. Discussion included support from administration, operations, parking, etc. Mainly opposed to weekly closure. Feedback from the restaurants that would be in favor of this. Funding to construct the outdoor tents, storage for the structures, designs, etc. Discussion regarding businesses that are located within downtown regarding using the parking. Discussion regarding insurance and risk analysis regarding having diners near moving vehicles. TAB had discussed encouraging the city to continue the streeteries along Cole Street. Chevassus believes that the restaurant owners are the main benefits from this. If we get by in from the other businesses, this may be a good thing. Wright asked should the city pay to construct these items, or not fund this. Action items were discussed and if this item could be included on the Planning Commission work plan. Wright states that this item does need to be brought up for discussion for council.
