***THE MEETING BEGAN AT 5:00 PM AND ENDED AT 5:27 PM. COUNCILMEMBERS JOHNSON AND CHEVASSUS WAS PRESENT AS WELL AS STAFF MEMBER CHRIS PASINETTI.***

#### **I. OLD BUSINESS**

- A. Port of Seattle Grant. Pasinetti informed the committee of the years Port of Seattle Grant cycle and the timeline for application. Pasinetti gave some ideas of what the grant could be used for this year. The committee indicated they would review and research ideas for the grant application. Possibly consider using the funding for tourism or use for events at the King County Fair Grounds.

#### **II. NEW BUSINESS**

- A. Addressing for newly annexed areas. Pasinetti discussed with the committee regarding the need to change the addresses for newly annexed homes and properties. This would change addresses from the county convention to the city convention. Pasinetti explained that this is necessary to maintain a high level of first responder timing among other items. This discussion is needed as in the past, the city council has not required address changes within the city which has led to some streets having addresses on two sides of the same street that are different. Pasinetti intends on having a virtual community meeting with the Sierra Vista Neighborhood as well as setting up a website with a Frequently Asked Questions that answers the question is my address going to change. Councilmember Johnson stated that he feels that staff's recommendation is important and if changing the addresses is necessary he would take that into consideration.
