COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMITTEE (CSC)

- I. CALL TO ORDER: Councilmember Wright called the meeting to order at 5:02pm.
- II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM 4/15/19: Motion to approve by Councilmember Jacobson, second by Councilmember Binion. Motion passed.
- III. COUNCIL ACTION ITEMS
 - a. CDBG – Larson indicated that the CDBG Grant Pre - application was accepted and we were approved to complete the full application. Council will need to authorize grant submittal. Motion to approve grant submittal by Councilmember Wright, second by Councilmember Binion. Motion passed.
- IV. DISCUSSION ITEMS
 - a. Relocation of Boise Creek at the Golf Course by Puyallup Tribe: Scott Woodbury, Assistant Public Works Director explained the impacts of relocating the Boise Creek at the Golf Course on water rights and the watershed. We will need to keep him informed of the decision made by Council and the new Golf Course operator so he can communicate to WIRA as part of the Exempt Well Mitigation Plan proposal. Relocation would be beneficial not only for the course to help mitigate flooding, but also for Salmon habitat.
 - b. Pool conceptual design update: We have received one quote from Schemata Workshop with a scope and cost for conceptual design in the amount of \$20,000. Michelle and Kristin will work to obtain 2 more quotes and then bring forward with a recommendation to proceed.

- c. (Added discussion item) Landscaping/Beauty Award: Councilmember Binion brought up an idea of helping beautify our community by implementing an award of some kind to a community member who has displayed good care of their landscaping. Partnering with the Garden Club or Chamber to manage the program was discussed. More to come at a later meeting.

 - d. (Added discussion item) Community Garden: Councilmember Binion asked about how the Community Garden plots looked. Larson indicated that 20 of the 24 plots were rented, but until growth starts occurring, we won't know if all are being maintained. City staff rototilled the garden in March.
- V. ADJOURNMENT: The next meeting, the CSC would like to do a park tour. Motion to adjourn by Councilmember Binion, second by Councilmember Jacobson, motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 6:00pm.
