- I. CALL TO ORDER: Sauvageau called the meeting to order at 5pm.

- IV. DISCUSSION ITEMS
  - a. Pickleball Facility: Concerns with funding, location, “dedicated funding”, dedicated operation and maintenance being told there are partnerships, but those aren’t 100%. The CSC feels that at this time, there is not interest in pursuing this as a partnership but might consider letters of support, but in order to make this more viable, there needs to be more of a plan for operations and maintenance, etc. Based on the current plan, the answer is really no.
  - b. MacFarland Park Storywalk: Brett will be preparing a Letter of Agreement to include maintenance, operation, right to remove, etc. Also will include a list of books approved by Library Board. The idea here is to “keep” things to being controversial, not to make a big deal. Making sure that it’s not excluding, but to be inclusive for all. Once the LOA is complete, the CSC can review and then it can be sent to KCLS.
  - c. Anderson’s Riverview Park: Concerns: Should there be an opportunity for others to have the opportunity to be the caretaker? What are the standards of care? I think this is something that needs to be taken slow. Can it be deeded back? Can it be sold? It’s not a bad idea, but there needs to be some really thoughtful and intentional to make sure things run smoothly.
  - d. Project updates - Montgomery, Farmer’s, Community Center
  - e. Rhododendron Garden: Concerns: Level of Service, location, benefits to the City, it’s beautiful but can we manage more parks?
