MINUTES

COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMITTEE (CSC)

- I. CALL TO ORDER: Wright called the meeting to order at 5:01pm.

- II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM 7/19/2021: Motion to approve by Sauvageau, Second by Koopman, motion passed.

- III. COUNCIL ACTION ITEMS
 - a. Resolution No. 1729-Committing to a Downtown Pavilion: The committee reviewed the Resolution and are in favor of implementing a downtown pavilion into the Park Plan's 6-Year CIP.

- IV. DISCUSSION ITEMS
 - a. Story Walk-Library Advisory Board: Steven Bailey from the Library Advisory Board presented their idea for a permanent outdoor Story Walk to be installed in one of the City Parks (City would be primary partner). Other partners include KCLS, Friends of the Library, & Mutual of Enumclaw, and potential partners are GRCC Total cost for aluminum post model would be \$6,000. The request to use Lafromboise Funds in the amount of \$3,500 is the intention for 2022. Other expenses (books, laminating, maintenance) would be covered by other partners.

- b. Skate Park-Larson asked CSC for their input regarding the demo of the skate park and funding for design and scope consultant for 2022 in order to get it out to bid for construction in 2023.
- c. Farmer's Park-Sauvageau is interested in the possibility of expanding/improving the Disc Golf Course. i/e. Tee pads, signage, etc. The Disc Golf Association would fundraise and install with the City Parks Department blessing. Will discuss with Park Board at September meeting.
- d. Anthony was approached by a realtor regarding a property that has Rhododendron gardens, and the property owner is curious if the City would be interested in purchase to be operated as a park. If interested, the City should set up a meeting with the realtor/property owner.
