



LOW INCOME SENIOR/DISABLED RATE REDUCTION FOR COMCAST CABLE TELEVISION SERVICE

City of Enumclaw Ordinance No. 2477, Section 4.3, provides for a reduced cable television rate for low-income seniors/disabled residents within the City of Enumclaw as provided by Washington State law. Such discounts will consist of thirty percent (30%) off of Basic Service or the Basic Service portion of expanded basic service when not discounted by inclusion in other promotional or programming package rates; and

Whereas, the following criteria for age and income have been established:

The head of household is 65 years of age or older and/or permanently disabled, with a family size of and a gross annual income from all sources of:

1 person: \$30,000 2 persons: \$34,250 3 persons: \$38,550 4 persons: \$42,800
5 persons: \$46,250 6 persons: \$49,650 7 persons: \$53,100 8 persons: \$56,500

The above guidelines effective March 9, 2011, and are subject to change as determined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
